

Family Museum Genealogy Database and Publications

In the Family History Room, Mother County Genealogical Society (MCGS) volunteers maintain a computer genealogy database as with over 86,000 entries (as of March, 2012). The database is centered on people who live or have lived in Bladen County and also includes family lines that have a Bladen connection but lived in other places. This database is a compilation of information from MCGS members and from other researchers contributing their research. Much of the information is from individuals simply wanting to add information on their immediate family so that it will be included in future family books. The database is regularly updated and improved by MCGS volunteers. New information is always welcome.
